Americans Debate New Ideas & Values

City populations grew, divided people between rural & urban lines

Urbanites followed the trend of Modernism- science and secular values over religious beliefs

Fundamentalism grew- The Bible was literal truth

Americans Debate New Ideas & Values

Scopes Trial- Trail over the teaching of Evolution in schools after John Scopes challenged Tennessee law.

William Jennings Bryan- Defended the right of rural values

While the Trial eventually found John Scopes guilty, the trial questioned public opinion

The Red Scare & Immigration

The American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) is formed to protect civil liberties

Sacco and Vanzetti Case- Two Italian Americans tried and put to death.

Scared mobs attacked radicals & immigrants to avoid potential communist revolutions.

The Red Scare & Immigration

Vladimir Lenin encouraged communist revolutions outside of the Soviet Union

The first American Red Scare began-fear that suspected communists were plotting revolution in the U.S.

The Palmer Raids- Series of raids that sought to arrest and deport suspected radicals

Immigration challenged the way Americans ran their lives

Nativists fought against immigration, other Americans supported it

Eugenics- The belief that intelligence & social traits were genetic & inherited by parents

The Emergency Quota Act of 1921 & The National Origins Act of 1924 established the quota system.

2% of immigrants from a nationality in the U.S. population living in 1890

Mexican immigration rose as the quota system did not apply to Mexico.

Racial Tension was on the rise.

The Ku Klux Klan (1915)- promoted hatred of African Americans, Jews, Catholics, & Immigrants.

Organizations such as the NAACP supported America's "Melting Pot"

Prohibition was ratified in the 18th Amendment in 1919 The Volstead Act enforced the law. **Bootleggers** sold illegal alcohol and speakeasies rose in popularity Al Capone capitalized from **Prohibition** Prohibition is repealed with the passage of the 21st Amendment
