The senate could appoint a Dictator, ruler who had complete control, during times of trouble.

### More Roman Government

### **Plebians-** farmers, merchants, & artisans who had little to no influence on government. They demanded more control.

**Tribunes-** Elected officials by plebians, would protect their interests.

## **Roman Society**

Men held the absolute power, especially fathers. Wives had to follow his rules

However, women would gain rights such as owning property, business, & could participate in the arts

Children from upper & lower classes learned to read & right. Usually from Greek tutors



Rome borrowed Greek religion, such as their god Zeus (Jupiter in Rome) as the ruler of the gods & skies!

## **Expansion & Military**

Rome would go on & conquer the entire Italian Peninsula & took over the Greek citystates
