Discrimination- Unequal treatment of a person based on a group they belong to such as race, ethnicity, religion, gender, sexual orientation, or ability





Describe types of discrimination that you think women may experience

Sexism

Sexism- The belief that one sex or gender group (usually male) is superior to the other & this justifies oppression





Institutional Sexism- Sexual attitudes & practices in organizations such as government, economy, & education that results in one sex having less power, wealth, & privilege










Be victims of sexual abuse: harassment, violence, & trafficking

Percent of population who did household activities on an average day







Women overall* 82 cents




Black women 63 cents




Native American women 60 cents

POVERTY RATES FOR ADULT WOMEN, 2017


