


Race as a Social Construct

Most scientist reject the concept of race as a biological fact

Race can be viewed as a social construct, crated by society but not based on facts

Concept of race did not exist until the 1500s to justify inequality

The concept of race is still important because racism IS real. Perceived racial categories can lead to harm

Since people's experiences are affected by perceived "race" then race is real


A person may select one or more race.

Note: Hispanic/Latino is considered an ethnicity by the government. Hispanics/Latinos may be of any race.*


Race
