

Exploitation of Land & Resources

Indigenous people in the US have lost nearly 99% of land they occupied

Some tribal lands contain resources such as oil, gas, timber, & are subject to attempts by private companies to expropriate land

Enbridge's Line 5 Pipeline: Built in 1953, has a long history of toxic spills. Goes through Chippewa territory in Michigan

Pebble Mine: Giant open-pit mine that looms over a salmon spawning territory

Oak Flat: Members of San Carlos Apache
Nation fighting the sale of sacred site to
foreign copper mining conglomerates




Poverty & Unemployment

About 33% of Native Americans live in poverty, & its only increasing

2021 the unemployment rate was 8.5% for Native Americans while national rate was 4.8%

On some reservations, 40% live in substandard housing, 33% are overcrowded, & only 16% have indoor plumbing



Health & Mental Care

Native Americans have a life expectancy that is 5.5 years less than all the U.S. race populations

Natives have higher rates of chronic diseases than any other ethnic group in the U.S.

Native Americans die by suicide at higher rates

In 2019 the leading cause of death for Natives






Lack of Educational & Economic Opportunities

In 2019, the high school drop out rate for Native Americans in the U.S. was 9.6% highest for any ethnicity

Just 17% of students continue education after high school, compared to 60% of US population

Reservation land is held in trust by the government, which prevents reservations from leveraging assets for loans



Mass Incarceration & Police Violence

2019 Natives were 2.1% of all federally incarcerated people, 2% of police killing

Confinement rates of youth are only second to black youth, exceeding white, Hispanic, & Asian combined

Youth experience disproportionate arrest rates & harsher outcomes for low level offenses




Violence Against Women


84% of Native women have experienced physical violence & over 56% sexual violence

90% of females have experienced sexual violence by a non-native perpetrator

Native women & girls are murdered at a rate 10x higher than the national average
