European Imperialism

Southeast Asia is the area of the sea between India & China

The Dutch, British, & French would use military & technology to colonize region

Dutch East India Company would command the Moluccas, The Spice Islands

Eventually The Dutch government takes control to expand plantations for profit



European Imperialism

Britain would control Burma & Malaya to enrich themselves with rubber & tin

France would tack over the Indochina region such as Vietnam creating French Indochina

The Kingdom of Siam (Thailand) remains independent in the region, signing treaties

King Mongkut modernizes the country & reforms the government

Britain & France use Siam as a buffer between them & the region of Southeast Asia expanded industry

Military Might & The Philippines

Spain takes control of the Philippines to spread Christianity

Jose Rizal- Doctor who practiced nonviolent protests only to be executed by Spanish, but inspired push back

> 1868- U.S. fights Spain in the Spanish-American War, destroying Spanish fleets & seizing control

> Emilio Aguinaldo creates rebellion against U.S. but is crushed. U.S. modernize the county to promise "self rule" in the future



Holdings in the Pacific

For much of the 1800s, whalers, merchants, & missionaries were only travelers to Pacific Islands

Britain, Germany, & U.S. create a triple protectorate over Samoa

Queen Liliuokalani of Hawaii tries to reduce foreign influence by American planters overthrow her & U.S. annexes Hawaii

The Pacific islands would be prized for resources & naval bases were built



Australia

1770- Captain James Cook "claims" Australia for Britain

Indigenous- Original inhabitants of a country, in Australia these are the Aboriginals

After the American Revolution, Britain would begin sending criminal to Australia

Penal Colony- Place to send people convicted of crimes

A booming wool industry & gold rush would encourage emigration to the country

Eventually Australia would set up an independent government that recognized the British crown



New Zealand

New Zealand was made up of the Māori tribe who arrived as seafaring people from Polynesia

Europeans began to colonized for whaling & the raising of sheep & cattle

Māori people fight back but drastically have numbers reduced

New Zealand also became an independent nation who recognized the crown
